▪ **Contents:**

Legal, administrative and bibliographic information concerning Swiss industrial designs:

- Protection begins from the date of filing and lasts for 5 years. Before the term expires, you will be notified of the possibility to renew protection. Protection can be renewed for another four terms of 5 years each. In other words, a design can be protected for a maximum of 25 years.
- 1st Publication Bulletin of the office: November 13th, 1981
- The update is programmed within 24 hours of reception of the data from the office.

▪ **Period covered:** From November 13th, 1981. Images from 1987.

Designs numbered 112001 and higher are included in the database

Specifications on some search fields:

- Design Number: Any multiple designs in a single application are broken into 1 record per design, sharing a single parent number in the format x number of digits – y number of digits, where “x” is the parent design number and “y” is an incremental suffix number, also called child.

Remarks: For a comprehensive search of all industrial designs having effect in France, we recommend a search covering **SWISS, INTERNATIONAL** and **EUROPE** registers.
